travelled to 19 countries on 5 continents fulfilling speaking engagements and a dream of world travel that he had harboured for decades james realised very early in his toastmasters club training that the best way to capture and retain an audience's attention was with the use of humour so making his audience laugh became james main focus these speeches are his favourites making his audience laugh is still the greatest high that james gets from speaking when you say something funny and your audience laughs you know that it's a genuine response and you've got through to them james says actually you will find that james uses many of his humorous speeches to deliver some very important messages to his audience it's incredibly hard to get an audience's attention when talking about a serious subject james continues but by using humour you capture their attention and they listen more carefully

to make sure they don't miss out on your next joke or funny line that's the perfect time to hit them with something important something profound you can then rest assured that your message has been heard loud and clear then it's back to more humour you can't afford to let them doze off for a minute public speaking is quite an art and James Taris has Toastmasters to thank for teaching him the
